



STEVE VOGT MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Award Amount: \$10,000

The Bitterroot Conservation District announces the availability of a \$10,000 (\$2,500 per year for four years) scholarship in honor of long time Bitterroot Conservation District board member and rancher, Steve Vogt.

The Bitterroot Conservation District (BCD) offers this college scholarship to a qualified local high school senior intent on pursuing a degree in natural resources or related field. Appropriate courses of study include agriculture, agronomy, animal/range/soil science, forestry, land resources, environmental science/engineering, hydrology, plant science, wildlife biology, etc.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Must reside in Ravalli County
- Must have a minimum grade point average of 3.5
- Must pursue a degree in natural resources or related field
- Will enroll full time in a Montana post-secondary school

Application Requirements:

- Complete application form to include: school transcript (4 years), list of extracurricular activities (include any leadership positions), volunteer community service, and employment.
- Two letters of recommendation from instructors/mentors, employer, community leader.
- An essay, not to exceed 500-words explaining: What is conservation of natural resources and why it is important to you?
- Finalists will be asked to attend a BCD board meeting to discuss their educational plans and goals.

Application must be submitted and received by 5:00 pm on the 15th of March 2022.

*If awarded a scholarship, the student will be required to submit additional paperwork confirming their enrollment at the school/college they will be attending along with payment information. With proof of enrollment, payment will be made by the BCD directly to said school. **This information is due by 5:00 PM on June 30, 2022. Failure to turn in this paperwork on time could result in loss of scholarship.** Students must maintain an overall GPA of 3.0 to be eligible for the following year's scholarship.*
