Soil Health Assessments include:

- Evaluation of soil structure, possible compaction, potential for erosion
- Infiltration tests
- An assessment of the soil biology, organic matter & crop condition
- Discussion of soil health practices such as designing cover crops, integrated grazing systems, and improving soil carbon

Healthy soils are vital for effective nutrient cycling, promotion of good root growth, improving sustainable yields, increasing resiliency to drought and temperature extremes, and reducing disease and pest problems.
